

Intellectual and/or Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) Waiver Quality Improvement Advisory (QIA) Council Overview and Membership Recruitment

Purpose: The I/DD Waiver QIA Council provides guidance and feedback to the Department of Human Services' (DoHS's) Bureau for Medical Services (BMS) and its contracted operating agency, Acentra Health (formerly Kepro), for ongoing quality assurance and improvement systems for the I/DD Waiver Program. The Council is made up of I/DD Waiver Program members and their families, provider agency representatives, other stakeholders such as community members and advocates, state agencies, grant-funded providers, and advocacy groups.

Meetings: The Council meets quarterly in person or virtually. Meetings are open to the public to observe and discuss any questions, comments, or concerns with the Council at the end of the meetings.
